Winter Bud Hardin	ss Monitoring in 2013


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Our annual monitoring of bud hardiness levels started again last week. We collected samples from six vineyards around the Finger Lakes region, using the same four primary varieties as in the past - Concord, Cayuga White, Cabernet Franc and Riesling. You can find the results from these first samples <u>at the project's webpage</u>.

Overall, hardiness levels for each of the varieties are where we would expect them to be by this point in the season. Average hardiness for each variety (expressed as  $LT_{50}$ , or the temperature at which 50% of the buds are killed) over the 6 sites is:

- Concord: -17.4° F
- Cayuga White: -12.7° F
- Cabernet Franc: -10.2° F
- Riesling: -12.5° F

Because we only have one data point for our vineyard samples so far, we don't have graphs showing the trends over the winter for those locations. However, Bill Wilsey has been collecting samples from the research vineyards in Geneva since November



so we can see how the hardiness has changed over time so far in that location. As we have seen in years past, the warm-up that we had in the first part of this month caused the vines to lose about 4-5 degrees of hardiness compared to where they were at the beginning of the month. If we manage to keep the recent colder weather, I expect that we'll see the hardiness head lower again.

As you can see, though, we haven't reached temperatures that approach the LT50 values that we have found so far, so at this point there doesn't seem to be any need to adjust pruning levels to accommodate any kind of winter bud injury.

## 2013 Pesticide Training And Recertification Classes

February 4, 11, 18, 25, 2013 7 – 9:30 p.m. Cornell Cooperative Extension Cente 480 North Main Street, Canandaigua, NY 14424

A series of pesticide training and recertification classes are being offered by Cornell Cooperative Extension. Anyone interested in obtaining a pesticide certification and meets the D.E.C. experience/education requirements should attend, along with current applicators seeking pesticide recertification credits. This training is NOT a 30-hour certification course. The exam is being offered on Monday, March 4, 2013 from 7 – 11 p.m.

The cost for the pesticide training to obtain certification is \$140.00, includes training manuals and attendance at all four classes. This does not include the \$100.00 DEC exam fee, due the day of the exam. Certified applicators, private and commercial, seeking recertification credits will receive 2.5 core credits per class. The cost for recertification is \$75.00 for all four classes or \$20.00 per class.

These two-day workshops are targeted at those farmers who are being required by buyers to provide third party verification of their food safety practices and for farmers thinking about moving in this direction. With the Food Safety Modernization Act draft FDA regulations to be released in the very near future, the timing of these workshops is paramount. Although the 2-day workshops will cover the vast majority of what most 3rd-party audit companies require, it will be geared towards the new Harmonized GAPs standards that Wegmans and many other retailers are requiring. These are sponsored by Genesee Valley Regional Market Authority (except the Long island training), Cornell Cooperative Extension, Cornell University, the Produce Safety Alliance, and the New York State Department of Ag & Mkts.
