In The Vineyard

Hopefully everyone made it through the rains on Monday without any flooding. Some weather stations reported over 4 inches of rain while some in the southern end of the Finger Lake had less than $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch. The rain was welcomed in most vineyards around the area where totals for July were well below average. Hopefully this rain won't trigger too much shoot growth, as the vines should be slowing down for the most part soon.

Looking at table 1 you can see that the northern and western parts of the Finger Lakes received the majority of the rain. At the teaching vineyard our weather station recorded 2.22" total. In some spots where downy mildew has been a problem growers may want to consider reapplying protectant fungicides that could have been washed off.

As Hans mentioned last week we are seeing many concord blocks with larger than average crops again this year. Most of the concord blocks I have been in this week around Keuka, and Canandaigua Lakes seem to be average or above, with some blocks in particular being well above average.

IPM

As growers continue to leaf pull and open up the canopy more we are finding increased instances of powdery and downy infections on clusters. Most likely as growers tied up renewals to replace trunks after last winter they made it harder to get good spray penetration to the fruit. It's a classic catch-22. Also with less fruit canopies are just bigger in general. By now most varieties should be resistant to new fruit infections so it just becomes a case of controlling what infections are there now and keeping leaves clean to help ripen the crop. Over the past week most growers have been applying bunch-closure botrytis sprays on susceptible varieties.

According to the [grape berry moth model on NEWA](#) the second generation is feeding inside the berry at this point. Growers should be scouting for feeding symptoms soon and be ready to spray at 1620 GDD if you are above the 15% threshold. I have seen some extensive berry moth damage already this week and with the small crop in some vinifera blocks it might be a good idea to protect what crop is left. Berry moth damage is a great entry point for botrytis infections and since we have had some ideal conditions for botrytis already it will be important to keep a close eye on blocks with heavy berry moth pressure. Recently I have been seeing some grape leafhopper damage showing up in some blocks. [For information on grape leafhopper please refer to the fact sheet here](#).

Mexican Consulate Will Visit Geneva

The Mexican Consulate will be visiting Geneva on July 31, August 1 & 2 to provide consular services to the Mexican citizens residing in upstate New York who are in need of a Passport or Consular ID Card for identification matters, travel purposes, or to prove their Mexican nationality. They will also be assisting people in documenting dual citizenship.

The "Consulate on Wheels" will be hosted by the Cornell Farmworker Program and the Finger Lakes Coalition of Farmworker Agencies at the Geneva Community Center, 160 Carter Road, Geneva, NY. The consulate is providing this service in upstate New York to ease the burden of traveling to New York City to renew and obtain important documents. Identification documents also ease the process of opening a bank account, getting a tax payer ID number, and establishing dual citizenship if needed.

Appointments will be available on Thursday (July 31) between 2- 7 PM and on Friday and Saturday (August 1-2) from 9AM to 2PM.

Registro de Nacimiento de hijos de padre y/o madre mexicanos nacidos en el extranjero

Para hacer el registro de nacimiento de sus hijos tiene que cumplir con los siguientes requisitos:

1. Hacer una cita telefónica mediante el sistema MEXITEL marcando el número Mexitel 1-877-639-4835. En el menú deberá elegir la tecla 3 de Registro Civil, y precisar que su cita la solicita en un Consulado sobre Ruedas y no en la sede en Manhattan.
2. Llenar la solicitud. La puede encontrar en el siguiente vínculo:

3. Presentarse los papás y el menor el día y hora de su cita en con los siguientes documentos originales y dos copias fotostáticas:
 - a. Acta de Nacimiento de Estados Unidos del menor en la forma detallada. (El Consulado General se quedará con el original de esta acta de nacimiento)
 - b. Prueba de nacionalidad e identidad de los padres que pueden ser los siguientes:
 - i. Pasaporte vigente (Si uno de los padres es extranjero, es obligatorio que presente su pasaporte extranjero vigente).
 - ii. Certificado de Matrícula Consular vigente.
 - iii. Acta de nacimiento y credencial del Instituto Federal Electoral (IFE) o Cartilla Militar.
 - c. Si el acta de nacimiento del menor no tiene la hora, fecha, nombre del hospital donde nació el menor y el nombre del médico que atendió el parto, es recomendable que presente la tarjeta del cu-nero o la tarjeta de las huellas de sus bebe y 2 copias.



REQUISITOS PARA PASAPORTE Y MATRÍCULA CONSULAR PRIMERA VEZ

MAYORES DE EDAD

1. Acta de nacimiento original y una copia tamaño carta.
2. Identificación oficial con fotografía y una copia tamaño carta.

Ejemplos: Credencial del IFE; certificado de primaria, secundaria o preparatoria con fotografía sellada; cartilla del servicio militar, licencia de manejo de Nueva York, Nueva Jersey o Connecticut; Pasaporte y/o Matrícula; credencial escolar acompañada de la boleta de calificaciones más reciente.

3. Dos fotografías recientes de frente, a color, fondo blanco, sin lentes, cabeza descubierta, expresión neutra y boca cerrada. Tamaño 1.5 x 1.3/4 pulgadas.

MATRÍCULA CONSULAR

1. Acta de nacimiento y una fotocopia tamaño carta.
 2. Identificación oficial con fotografía y una fotocopia tamaño carta.
 3. Comprobante de domicilio a nombre del interesado (recibo de luz, teléfono, cable, comprobante de cuenta bancaria, contrato de arrendamiento o un sobre recibido por correo) y una fotocopia.
- Si ya cuentas con pasaporte sin observaciones, sólo debes presentarlo con una copia de la primera y última página – y un comprobante de domicilio a tu nombre.
 - Para el trámite de matrícula consular de menores de edad deben comparecer ambos padres y presentar sus identificaciones con fotografía; así como el acta de nacimiento del menor interesado.

MENORES DE EDAD

1. Acta de nacimiento del menor y una copia tamaño carta.
2. Identificación oficial con fotografía y una copia tamaño carta.
 - Para menores de 7 años, carta firmada por el pediatra con fotografía sellada y cartilla de vacunación.
 - Para mayores de 7 años, credencial de la escuela con fotografía, acompañada de la boleta de calificaciones; o tira de calificaciones con fotografía, firmada y sellada por la escuela.
 - Los menores nacidos en EEUU pueden presentar como identificación el pasaporte estadounidense vigente.
3. Deberán comparecer ambos padres y presentar sus identificaciones con fotografía.
4. Dos fotografías recientes de frente, a color, fondo blanco, sin lentes, cabeza descubierta, expresión neutra y boca cerrada. Tamaño 1.5 x 1.3/4 pulgadas.

MUJERES CASADAS

Las mujeres casadas que deseen que el nombre u apellidos de su esposo aparezcan en su pasaporte o matrícula, debe presentar:

- Acta de matrimonio mexicana
- Acta de matrimonio de Estados Unidos
