PHENOLOGICAL STAGES: Eichhorn-Lorenz Stages



Winter dormancy: winter bud scales more or less closed



Bud swelling: buds expand inside the bud scales



Wool (doeskin stage): brownish wool clearly visible



Bud burst: green shoot first clearly visible



First leaf unfolded and spread away from shoot

Five to six leaves unfolded: inflorescence clearly visible



Inflorescence elongating: flowers closely pressed together



17 Inflorescence fully developed: flowers separating



Beginning of flowering: first caps falling




21 Early flowering: 25% of caps fallen

25 Late flowering: 80% of caps fallen




Fruit set: young fruits begin to swell, remains of flowers lost
